### YOUR 2023 IMPACT



Through your generosity, we provided sponsorship opportunities to a **total of 1729 vulnerable children**. Of these 802 were in **elementary schools**, 684 in **high schools**, 99 in **vocational and special education** institutions and 144 in **universities and colleges**. This number has remained relatively the same in the previous years. At our girl's high school, the 12<sup>th</sup> grade class that took their national exist exam last November performed exceptionally well, with **54% scoring well enough to join four-year degree programs** and the rest qualifying for three- and two-year college career programs.


#### Healthcare

In healthcare we made huge progress in completing Tumaini Mission level 4 Hospital. We could not have gotten to where we are today without the sacrificial giving by so many of you. We are on target to complete construction in **April this year and launch the new hospital in June**. Come join us in Kenya as we celebrate and do a grand opening **on June 27<sup>th</sup>**, **2024!** Our plan is to purchase the required equipment in phases in the next few years. We treated a total of **34,715 patients** in 2023, a significant increase from the previous year's number, **22,000 patients**! In addition, we provided counseling services to **28,290 adolescents**.

# Socio-Economic Development Programs

A total of **37,906** individuals were lifted from extreme poverty to self-sustainability. We continued our partnerships with several Community Based Organizations (CBOS) composed of women in extreme poverty situations. We offered them grants, water tanks and microloans. The other group that we gave a hand-up were Tumaini alumni. They benefited from our microfinance program, giving them opportunities to borrow money at interest rates unavailable in commercial banks and thus helping them start small businesses. Beneficiaries did businesses ranging from trading in animals, farming, boutiques, salon beauty shops and more. Thank you everyone who donated to our socio-economic fund and gave thousands of vulnerable families and youths an opportunity for dignity and self-sustaining.
